

FORMS

There are a number of forms that need to be signed at your prospectus defense and at your final thesis defense. Generally, these forms are interactive, i.e., you can pull up the link and type in your information, then print the form. Make sure you check the link the week before your defense so that you will have the most current form. Most of the links below link directly to the main page for thesis/dissertation preparation guide, where you can check the link for the form you want.

Forms you bring to your prospectus defense to be signed by committee (click the link below then choose *Forms* on the grad school website and you'll find these under thesis/dissertation forms):

- [checklist for students using non-APA style manuals/journals](#) – this form gives you exactly what needs to be in your final thesis, and in what order. **Make sure you have the non-APA checklist.** You will go over this form with your committee chair after you have completed your final thesis.
