Students without a valid TN teaching license must apply for and be admitted to the Teacher Education Program (TEP). Out of state students who are licensed to teach must obtain a valid TN teaching license. Application forms for TEP are available in Ball Hall room 202 or online at http://coe.memphis.edu/TCED/tep_app_gr.pdf. All teacher licensure students must present acceptable scores on the required Tennessee teaching license Praxis II content knowledge test as a pre-requisite for admission to the TEP. Licensure-only students must also pass the Pre-professional Skills Test (PPST) according to the criteria established by the TN State Board of Education to be admitted to TEP. Students must pass Praxis II content knowledge test for Physical Education before taking Advanced Clinical Practicum. All students must attend a mandatory Advanced Clinical Practicum meeting in fall or spring before their practicum.
