TO PURSUE THE DEGREE AND LICENSURE A CANDIDATE MUST:

- Pass all sections of the PPST (173 writing, 174 reading, 173 math)
- Pass the Praxis II content knowledge exam
- File for admission to the Teacher Education Program (this is separate from admission to Graduate School)
- Pass the TN Bureau of Investigation Fingerprint Background Check
- Maintain a 3.0. Candidates must have a 2.5 undergraduate grade point average.
